

RULES AND REGULATIONS

[Article 1](#)

The swimming school « LES MARSOUINS » has an agreement with the Ministry of Youth, Sports and Associations. Receipt of the declaration for physical and sporting activities.

[Article 2](#)

Mr Jean-Marie LAULHE is a member of the Lifeguard Federation. He therefore benefits from legal aid and public liability insurance.

[Article 3](#)

The swimming lessons are given by a qualified lifeguard, holder of a BEESAN certificate (Sports Education diploma for swimming) and all diplomas, certificates, and first aid qualifications are up to date.

[Article 4](#)

Security is assured by the lifeguard. Any accident will be noted in a report to the FMNS – 11 rue Henri Barbusse 33110 LE BOUSCAT. A first aid kit is to be found at the reception desk at all times.

[Article 5](#)

The inscriptions for the children's swimming lessons will be carried out at the reception desk by the parents, grandparents or any other adult of the family.

[Article 6](#)

The parents engage themselves to respect the timetable for which their child is signed up to. However, if they are unable to take part in the lesson, it will be carried out later.

[Article 7](#)

The entry into the water will be done exclusively with the lifeguard and his student. Leaving the water also. The parents will wait on the sides and will assist the lesson visually. The responsibility of the lifeguard will stop once the parents have collected their children.

[Article 8](#)

The school's activity is limited to learning and improving swimming. To the best of his ability, the instructor will lead each student to their best possible level according to their skills. All the materiel will be supplied by the school.

[Article 9](#)

The swimming school « LES MARSOUINS » is not responsible if shut for weather reasons, storms, forbidden swimming conditions. However, the lessons will take place at other times as soon as the weather conditions allow.

The activity will take place from 1st June 2015 until 15th September 2015, from 9.00am to 7.00 pm including weekends at the PORT VIEUX beach.
